## Traditional + ACE Pathway

Follow the traditional path and maintain A/B grades to qualify for ACE classes and earn up to 18 Sac. State credits.

Non-weighted classes:

- US History (11) 2 sem.**
- English (12) 2 sem.**
- Environ. Sci. (12) 1 sem.**
- US Gov't. (12) 1 sem.**

## Traditional Pathway

4 years of Core Classes required.  
Meets and exceeds CSU/UC "a-g" requirements to apply to UC/CSUs
